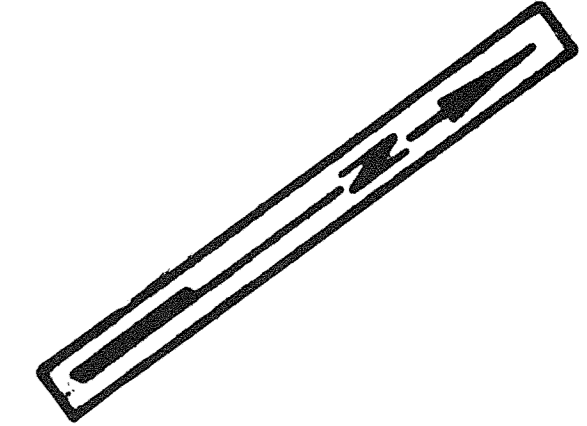


LEGEND:
